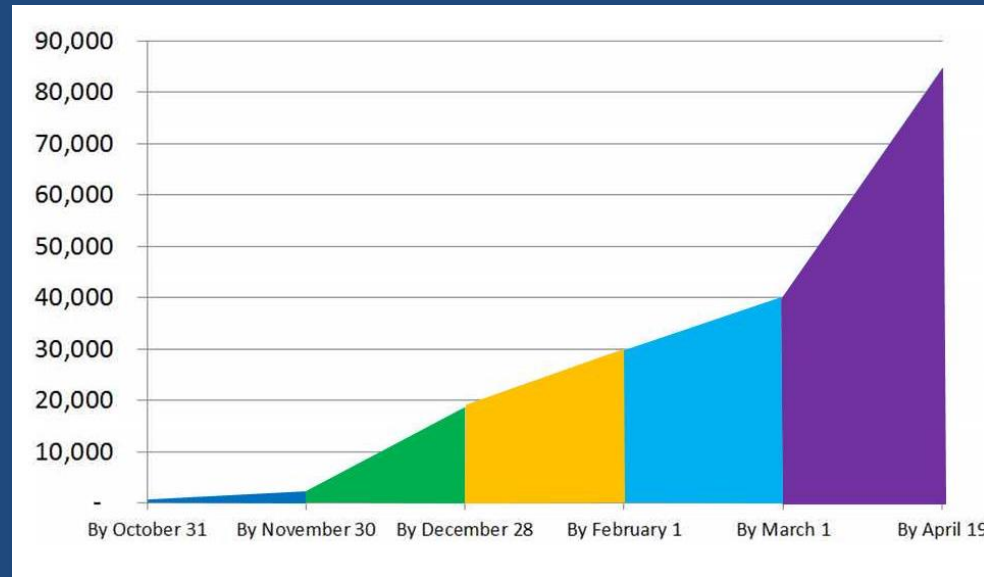

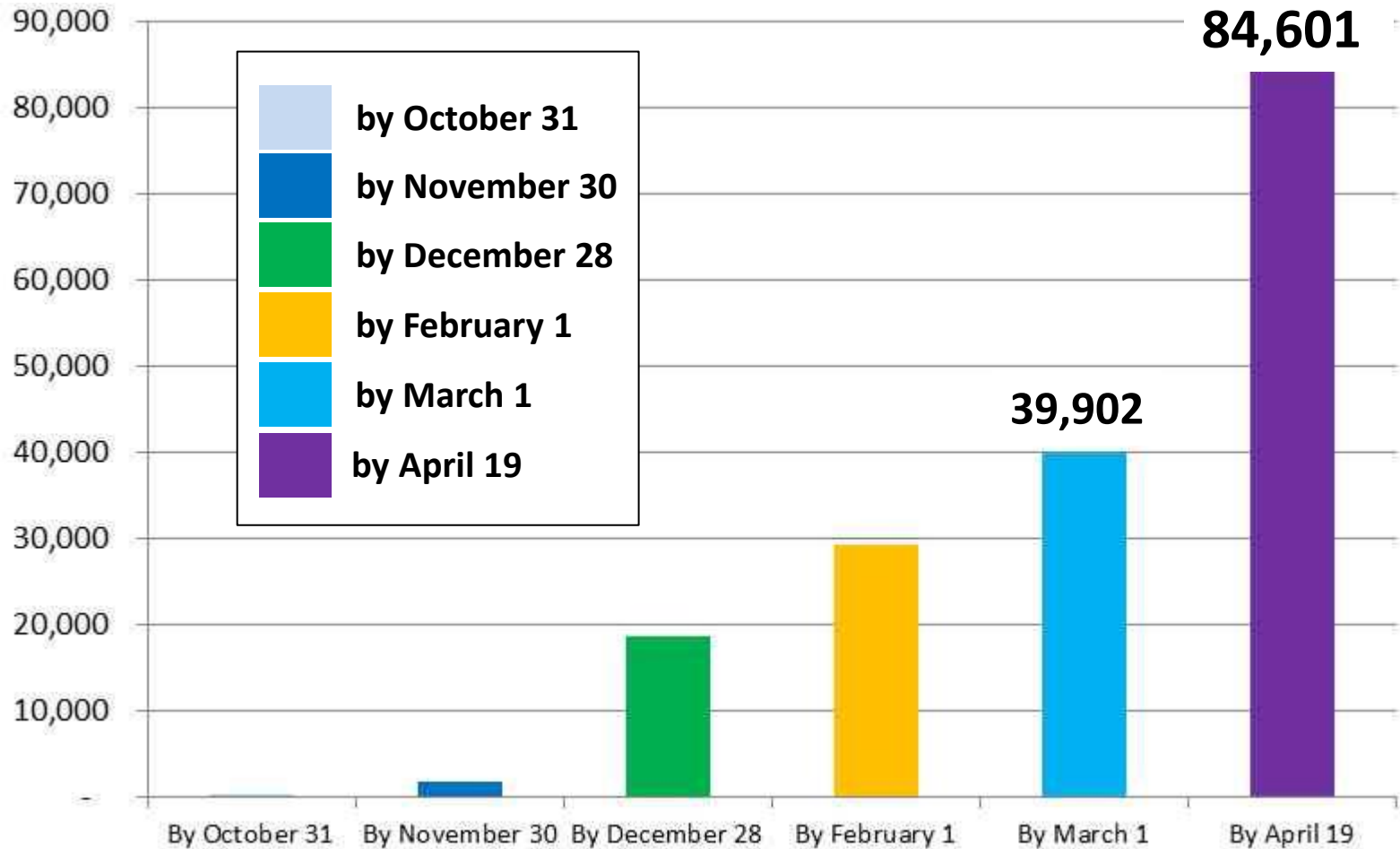

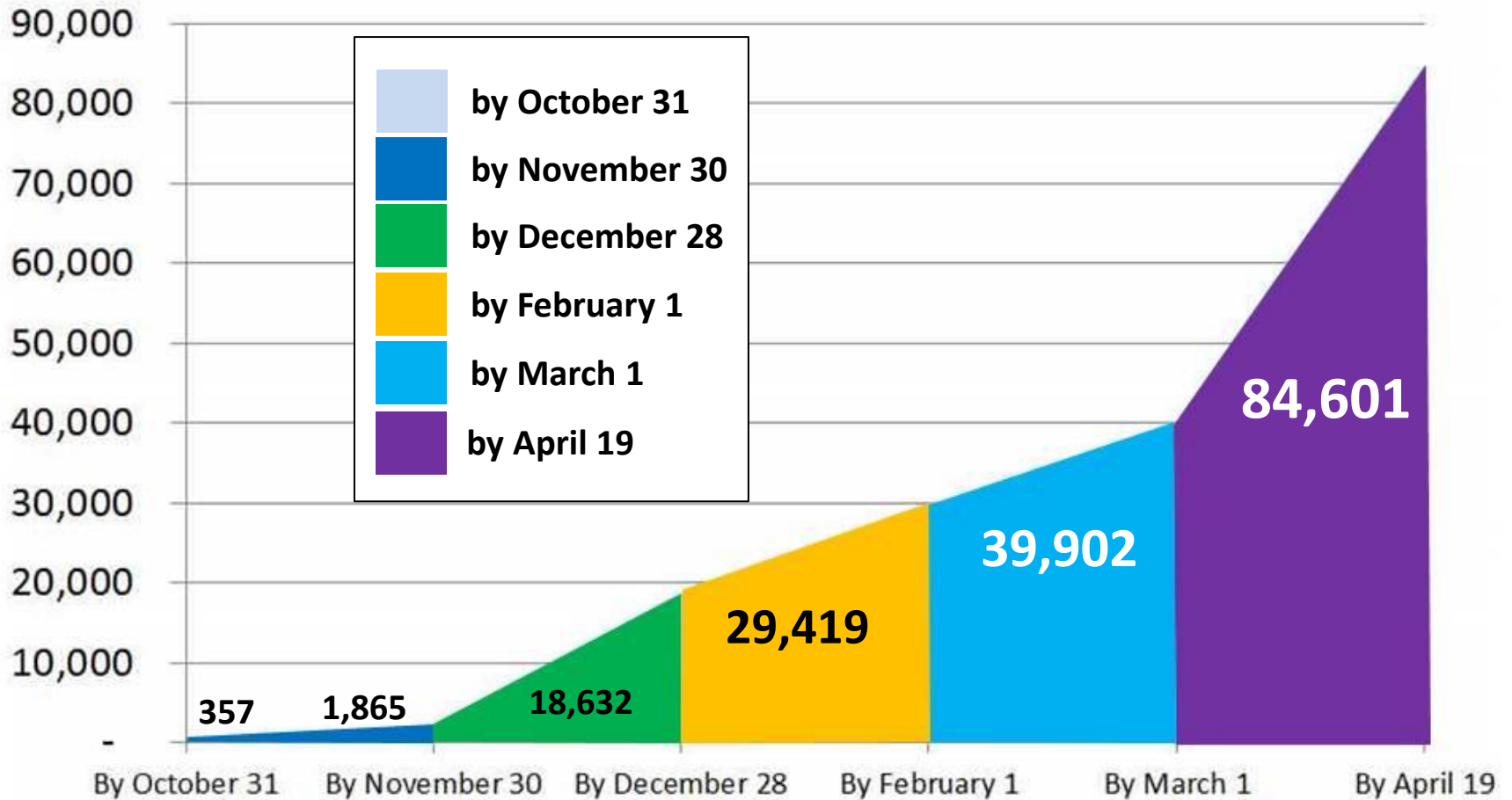

# Utah's pace of enrollment surged in March 2014

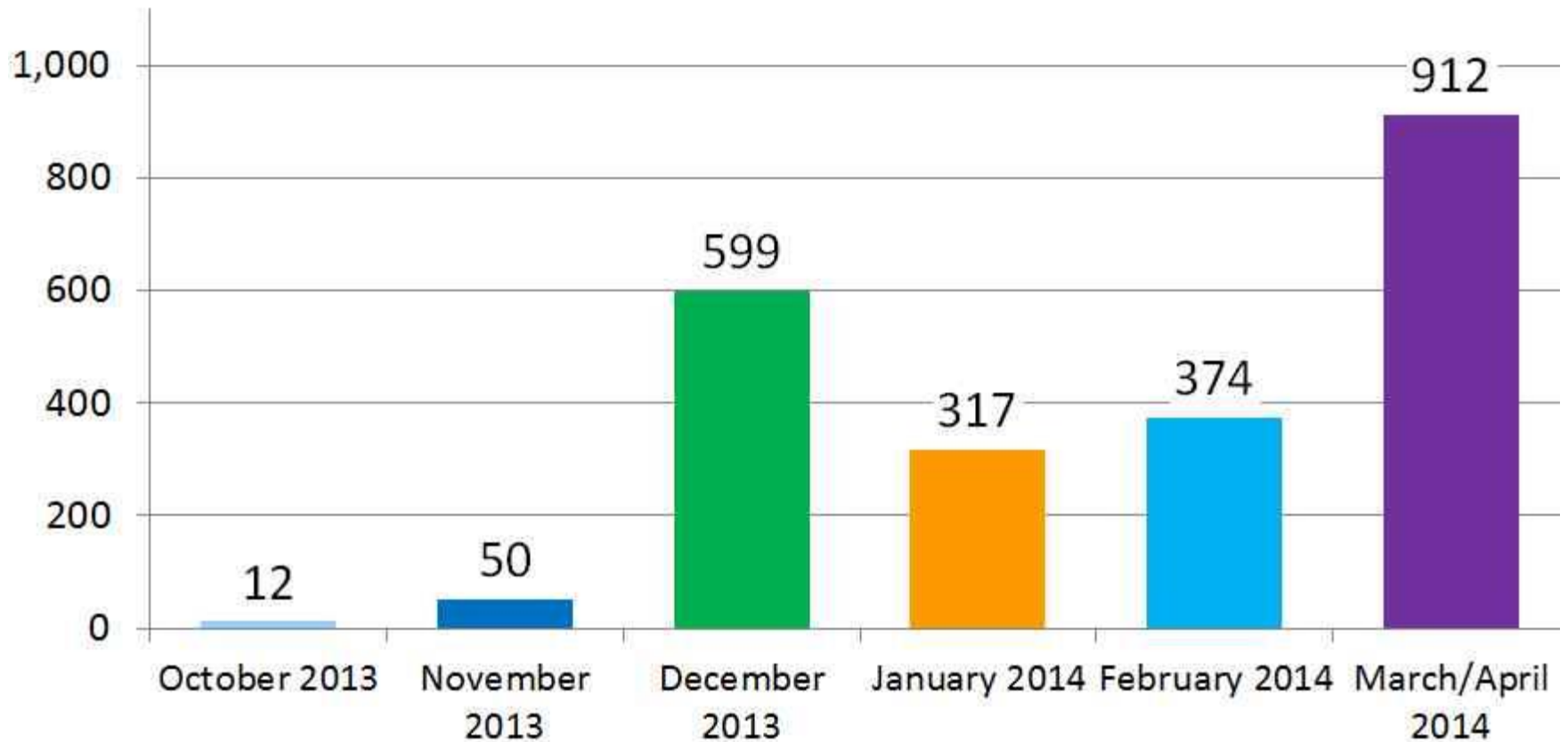

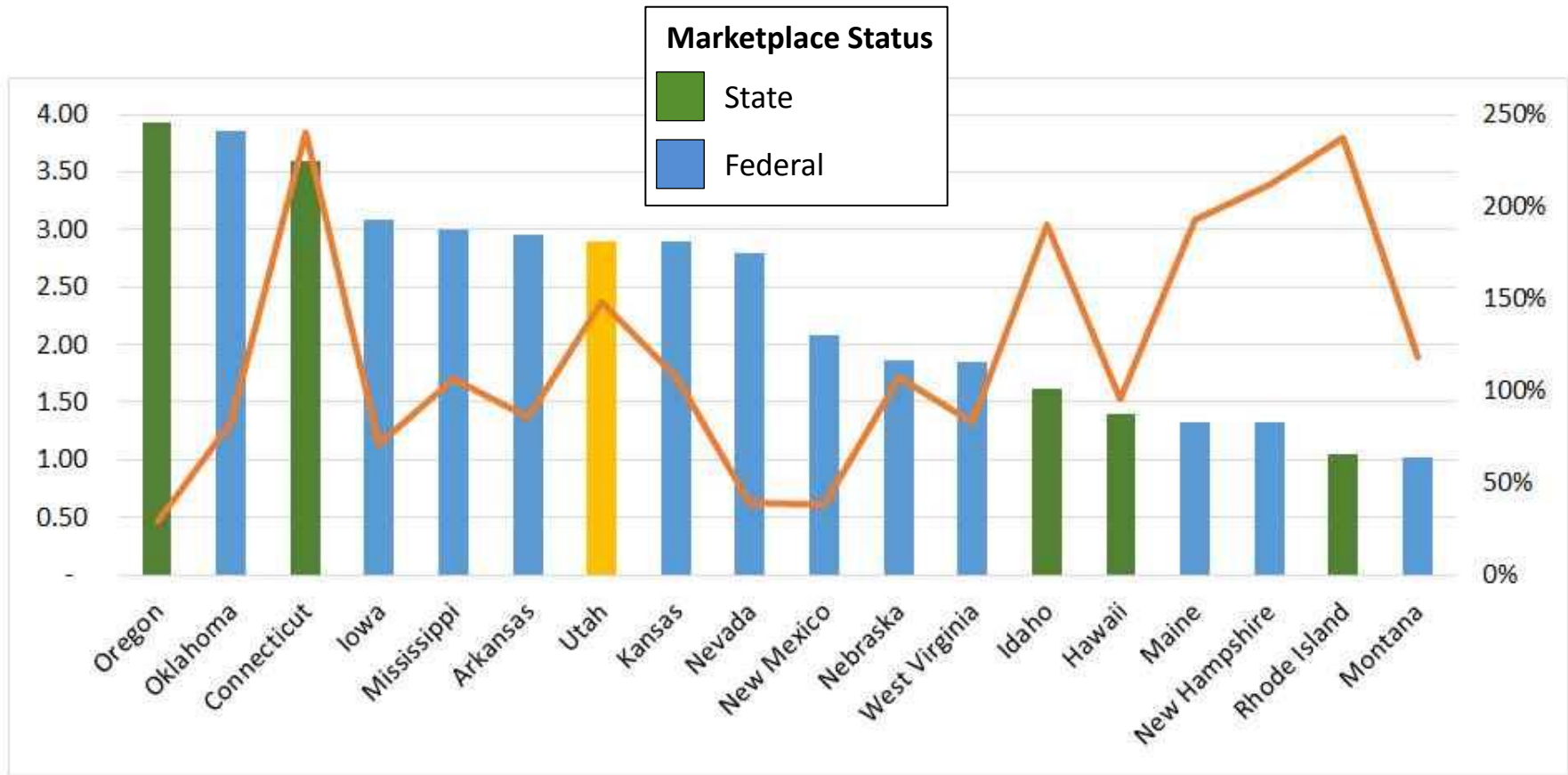
## ACA Sign-ups in Utah per Day (by month)

## % of enrollment goal met - by state population



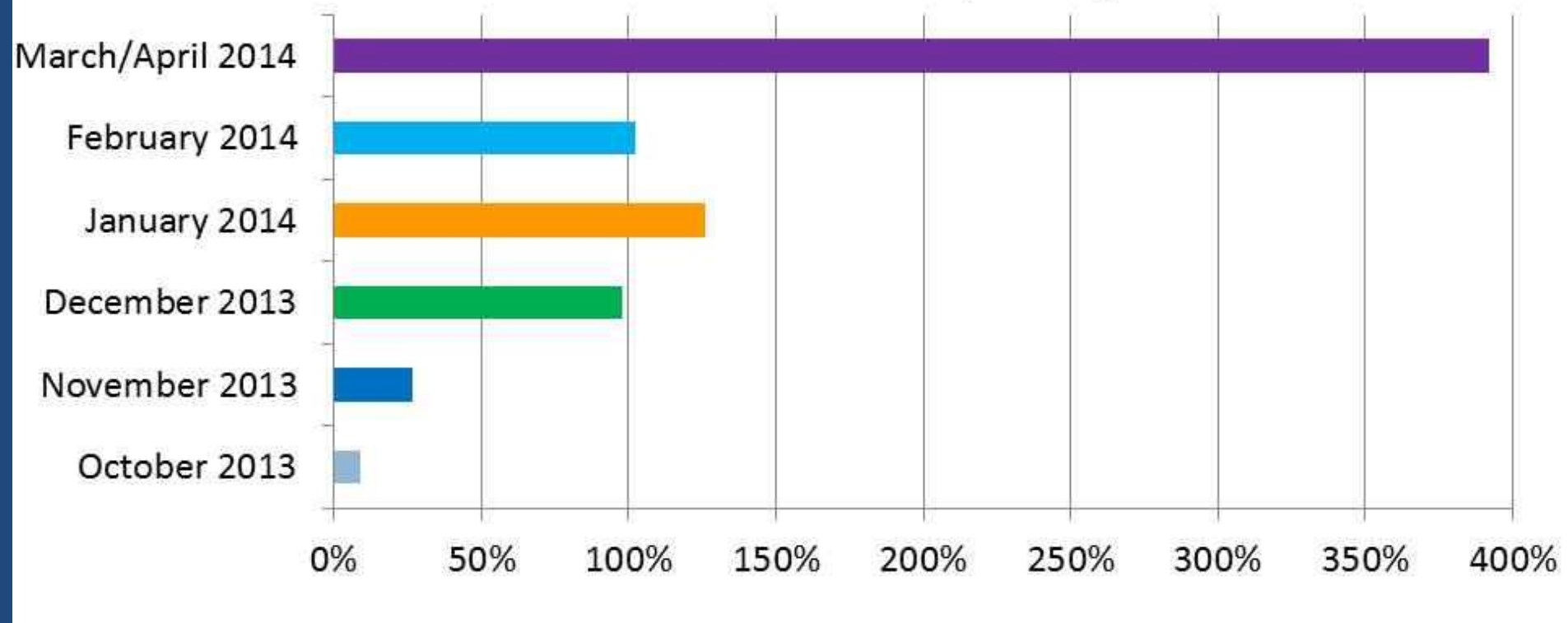
State population (in mil)

# Utah achieved 392% of its March enrollment goal

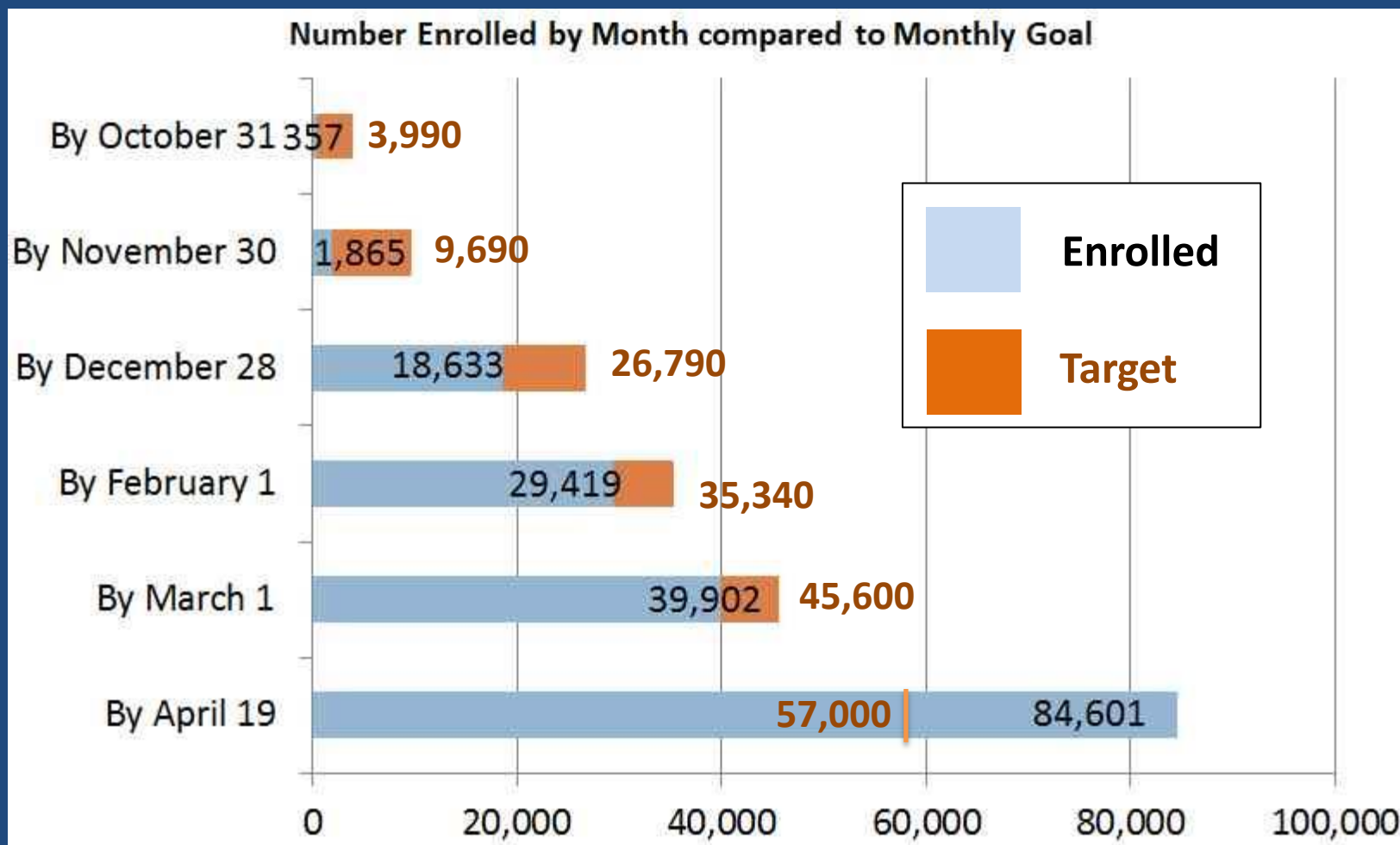

October 1, 2013 – April 19, 2014

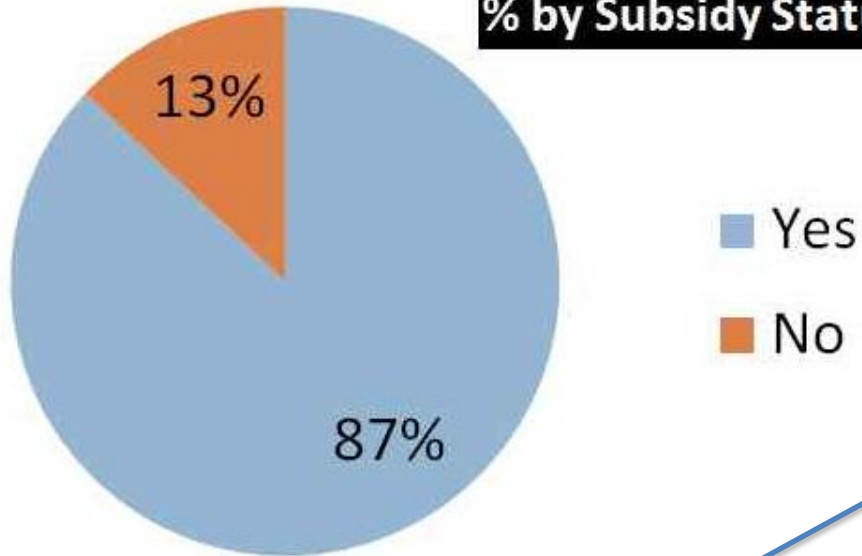


Utah reached 148% of its total enrollment target by April 19

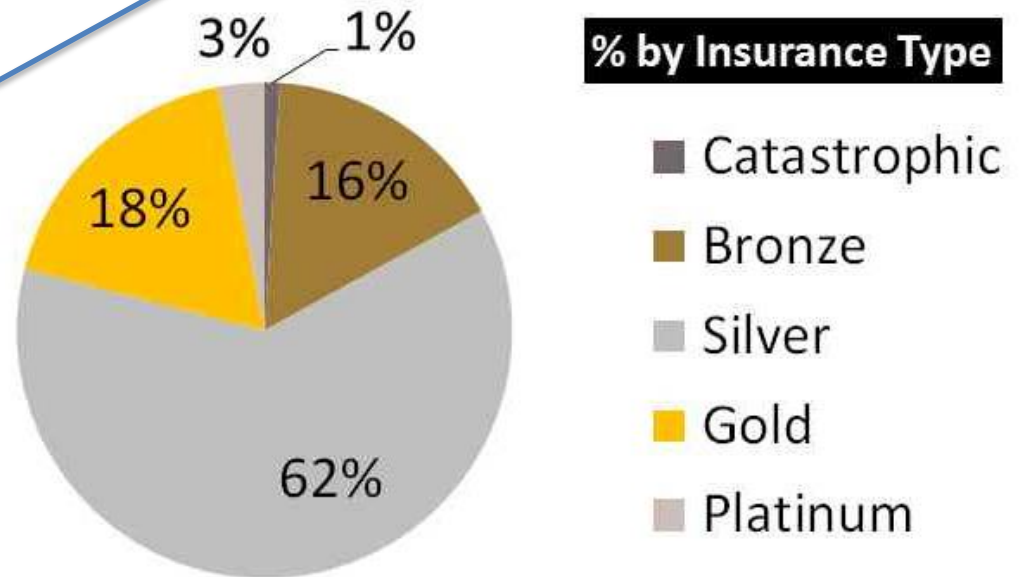
# 87% of Utahns qualified for premium subsidies

**% by Subsidy Status**



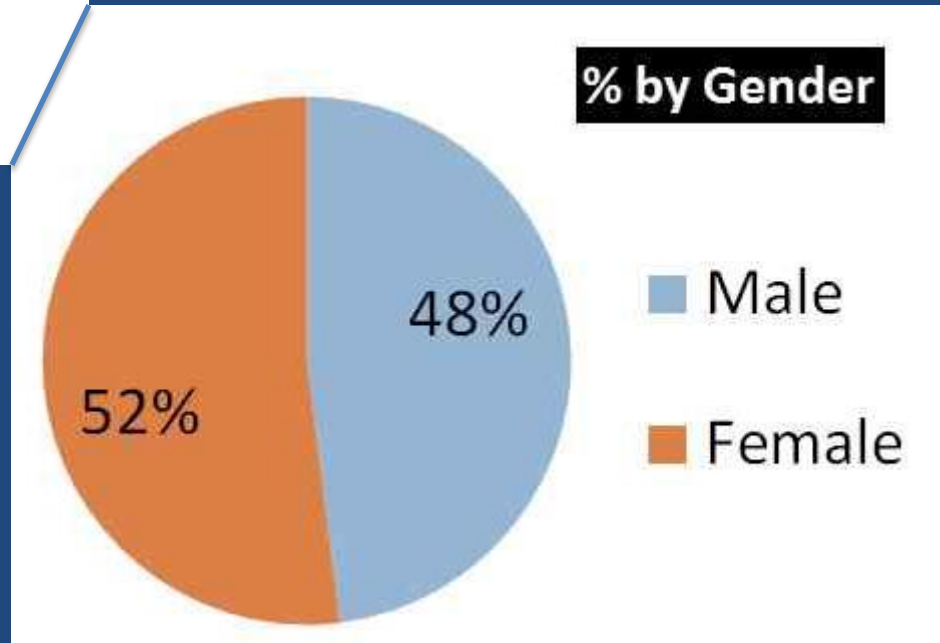
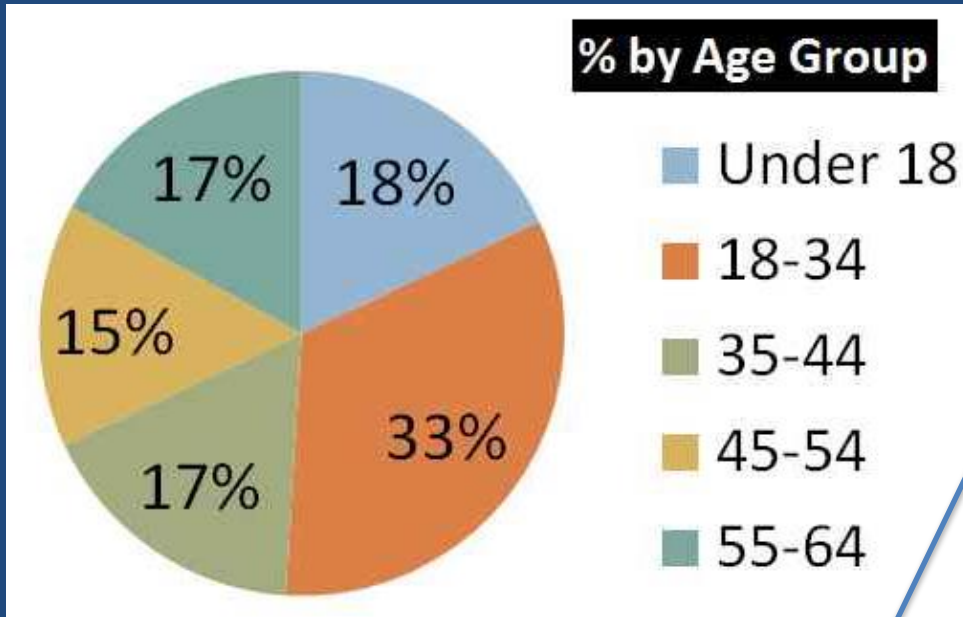
**% by Insurance Type**
